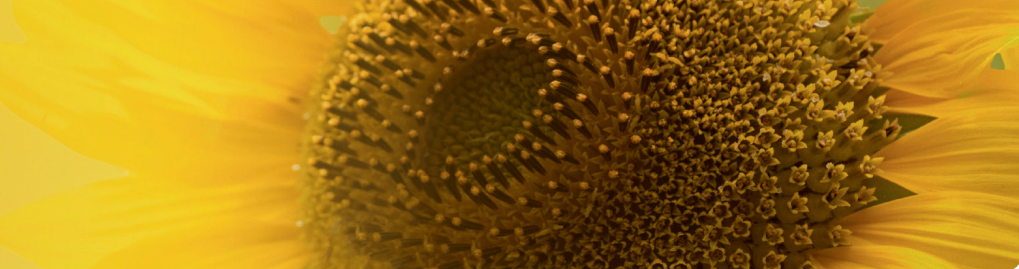
A Sustainable Bioeconomy

Originally established in 2007 to ensure the sustainability of biofuels, RSB expanded in 2013 to cover biomaterials and now offers the most comprehensive system for certifying bio-based feedstock.

RSB certification is recognised by WWF, IUCN and the Natural Resources Defense Council as the strongest and most trusted of its kind. The certification scheme is approved by RSB’s members, including leading NGOs and UN agencies.

Certification is based on the three pillars of sustainability:

Social

In areas of poverty, RSB ensures that the production of biomaterials enhances food security and local livelihoods.

Environmental

Certification mandates biodiversity preservation, as well as best practices in land and water management.

Economic

RSB works with the private sector and its multistakeholder members to make sure that sustainability requirements remain efficient and practical to implement.
